NET works update - Grove Avenue

Works have been taking place on Chilwell Road and High Road as part of the expansion of Nottingham's tram network to Beeston and Chilwell.

As part of these works, Park Road has been closed at its junction with High Road for approximately eight weeks so that telecommunications works can take place across the junction safely.

Access to properties is still available and a signed diversion route running from High Road, School Lane, Bramcote Lane and Bramcote Avenue is in place. Please note that Cator Lane is also currently closed to through traffic.

Following concerns about increased traffic on Grove Avenue and the impact on local residents, Grove Avenue will be closed just to the north of its junction with Dale Lane from Monday 21st October.

Access to J&B Autos and other properties on Grove Avenue to the south of the Dale Lane junction will still be available from Chilwell High Road.

A map showing the temporary road closures and diversion route for properties to the north of the Dale Lane junction is on the back of this leaflet.

Once the Park Road junction works are complete the major works on Chilwell Road will have moved down to the High Road, which means that Park Road and Grove Avenue will remain closed until spring next year, for safety reasons.

The works on Park Road are being carried out between 8am – 6pm, Monday – Friday and 8am – 6pm on Saturday, and are in accordance with the project's Code of Construction Practice.

We apologise for the inconvenience that the tram works may cause you, and would like to assure you we will do all that we can to keep disruption to a minimum.
