Dear David,

I certainly do not intend to apologise for standing up for the people of Broxtowe in defence of our Green Belt land.

In reply to your earlier email, I would urge Broxtowe Borough Council to assess the housing needs of the Borough and to bring forward a local plan, working with as opposed to against the people of the Borough, which allows sustainable development, to include new homes, new businesses, better public transport and imaginative open spaces, on brown field land. Such a plan should preserve existing Green Belt boundaries.
