**Boundary Fencing**

I write, as promised, further to my letter of 16<sup>th</sup> May regarding the above. I would like to take this opportunity to add that I also write on behalf of residents of Lime Grove Avenue and Clumber Avenue.

As I stated in my earlier letter, besides residents' requests for a minimum of 3m high fencing and an additional 0.4m of trellis, there are a number of associated issues which I wish to bring to your attention.

Firstly, clarification is required regarding the ownership and continued maintenance of the fence.

Secondly, clarification is required regarding the ownership and continued maintenance of the land between the new fencing and residents' current gardens. Related to this is the need for land levels to be re-instated and brought up to a suitable standard (the loss of earth is particularly noticeable at 26-30 Holkham Avenue). As for future maintenance of this land, residents are unsure as to how the tram operator would access that land. Therefore would this land be granted to residents, and if so, not only does the standard need to be acceptable as mentioned, but would the fences between properties be extended to the new fencing?

Thirdly, residents also wish to know whether the boundary fence will run parallel to the track.

Residents also require detail regarding the promise of replanting vegetation in order to afford some additional screening and privacy.



Additional concerns of residents include: whether there will be a fence between the track and the path on the opposite side of the line and whether there will be a fence between the track and Eskdale Junior School and Alderman Pounder Infant School & Nursery.

I would be grateful if these matters could be given your urgent attention and I repeat my earlier request that TWA visit and talk to those residents who are affected.
