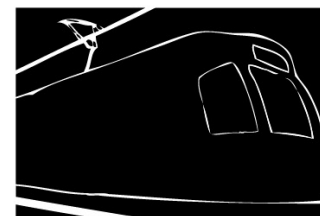

NET works update - Access to Holly Lane from 23 May



Tram track laying works have been taking place on Chilwell Road between its junctions with Middle Street and Ellis Grove, as part of the expansion of Nottingham's tram network to Beeston and Chilwell.

These works are almost complete and this part of Chilwell Road is due to reopen to traffic in early June, at which time Chilwell Road / High Road will close from Wilmot Lane up to Central College so that further track laying can take place. We will contact you shortly with more details about these works.

A new temporary access road is due to open on Friday 23 May. This road will provide alternative access to the Holly Lane industrial area via Queens Road West and Barton Way for deliveries, employees and access to free parking areas for the Chilwell Road shops. Signs showing the new route will be put up shortly.
