NET works update - Beeston Town Centre from 17 March

Works have been taking place in Beeston town centre as part of the expansion of Nottingham's tram service to Beeston and Chilwell.

The next stage of the tram works is to construct the tramway on Chilwell Road between the location of the old Wilkinson store and the Devonshire Avenue junction.

From Monday 17 March for approximately five months, while works to move utility services and to lay tram tracks take place, this section of Chilwell Road will be made one-way only from Middle Street and Devonshire Avenue towards Foster Avenue, for access to Foster Avenue Car Park, Beeston Library and Broxtowe Borough Council Offices.

The important existing pedestrian link between Beeston Town Centre and Chilwell High Road will remain open and vehicle access into and out of Devonshire Avenue from Middle Street will be maintained so that shoppers can continue to follow the existing diversion to the free Chilwell Road car park next to the Methodist Church.

A new link road has been built between Wollaton Road and Foster Avenue via Commercial Avenue, which will be used for traffic exiting Foster Avenue while these works take place.

These works will be carried out between 8am – 6pm, Monday – Saturday. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience that these works may cause you, and would like to assure you that we will do all that we can to keep disruption to a minimum.
