

NET works update – Bramcote Lane

As you may be aware, works to install a water culvert have been taking place along the Greenway, between Cator Lane and Bramcote Lane, as part of the extension of Nottingham's tram network to Beeston and Chilwell.

The next stage of these works involves working across Bramcote Lane, between its junctions with Sandby Court and Hall Drive.

To be able to carry out this work safely, the above section of Bramcote Lane will be closed to through-traffic from Monday 8th April until mid-June, and road signs have been in place for several weeks on Bramcote Lane advising motorists of the closure. Vehicle and pedestrian access to residential properties and Sandby Court will be maintained throughout.

A diversion route for traffic will run from Bramcote Avenue and Cator Lane to Hall Drive, and vice versa.

The NCT 36 and Yourbus Y36 bus services, which usually run down Bramcote Lane, will instead turn onto Eskdale Drive from Field Lane, travelling along Eskdale Drive and back onto Inham Road before turning back onto Bramcote Lane and joining their usual route. This means that bus stops BR0227 (on Field Lane) BR0154 BR0465 and BR0155 (on Bramcote Lane) will not be served by these bus services while Bramcote Lane is closed. The nearest bus stop for passengers wishing to get on / off services in this area will be on Inham Road close to the Bramcote Lane junction.

A map showing the bus diversion route is available on the back of this leaflet.

The works will be carried out between 8am – 6pm, Monday – Friday and 8am - 1pm on Saturday and will be in accordance with the Code of Construction Practice (CoCP), which was agreed at the NET Phase Two public inquiry held in 2007.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience that these works may cause you, and would like to assure you that we will do all that we can to keep disruption to a minimum.
