## **NET works update – Chilwell Road, Beeston**

As you may be aware, works to move and upgrade utility services have been taking place on Chilwell Road, as part of the ongoing works to expand Nottingham's tram system to Beeston and Chilwell.

The next stage of these works is due to begin shortly, and will take place in three phases.

### **Phase One: from Monday 14<sup>th</sup> January, for approximately one week**

So that these works can be carried out safely, temporary traffic lights will be in use on Middle Street opposite the Police Station, and at the junction of Chilwell Road, Middle Street and Devonshire Avenue.

### **Phase Two: from Monday 21<sup>st</sup> January, for approximately two weeks**

Temporary traffic lights will be in use on Chilwell Road, opposite the Police Station, during this phase of the works.

### **Phase Three: from Friday 1<sup>st</sup> February, for approximately four weeks**

Temporary traffic lights will be in use at the junction of Chilwell Road, Middle Street and Devonshire Avenue during this phase of the works.

Access to these roads will be maintained at all times and bus routes will be unaffected during each phase, however please allow extra time for your journey when travelling through this area.

These utility works will be carried out between 8am – 6pm, Monday – Friday and 8am - 1pm on Saturday, and will be in accordance with the Code of Construction Practice (CoCP), which was agreed at the NET Phase Two public inquiry held in 2007.

The CoCP regulates the way that works for NET Phase Two can be undertaken, and sets out standards for our contractor on issues such as controlling noise, vibration and dust. This will ensure that works are undertaken in a responsible and sympathetic manner.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience that these works may cause you, and would like to assure you that we will do all that we can to keep disruption to a minimum.
