

NET works update – Humber Road/Fletcher Road junction, from 4th November

As you will be aware, works have been taking place on Humber Road and Fletcher Road as part of the expansion of Nottingham's tram network to Beeston and Chilwell.

Works to move utility services and lay tram tracks at the Humber Road/Fletcher Road junction are due to begin on Monday 4th November and are due to be complete by early February 2014.

Humber Road will be closed at its junction with Fletcher Road and Middle Street during this time so that works to move a manhole can be completed safely. There will be no left turn from Humber Road onto Middle Street or right turn from Humber Road onto Fletcher Road.

Access to Fletcher Road, Lower Court and Lower Road will be available from Albert Road. Temporary traffic lights will be in use on Lower Road so that traffic can move through a narrow area of this street safely.

Access to Middle Street is still available from the north part of Humber Road. Businesses on Humber Road are open as usual and are accessible from Queens Road and the south part of Humber Road.

A map of the area is shown on the back of this leaflet.

These works will be carried out between 8am – 6pm, Monday – Saturday and will be in accordance with the project's Code of Construction Practice (CoCP).
