

NET works update - Neville Sadler Court

As you are aware, works have been taking place in Beeston and Chilwell as part of the extension of Nottingham's tram network.

The next stage of works in this area is to demolish part of the Neville Sadler Court complex where the tramline will run. This work will start on 4th March and is expected to take two weeks to complete.

Once the demolition works are complete, the rubble will be removed from the site so that it can be crushed and recycled, and we can use the space created to provide a temporary access route for residents and emergency vehicles, residential parking and a site compound.

These works will be carried out between 8am – 6pm, Monday – Friday and 8am - 1pm on Saturday and will be in accordance with the Code of Construction Practice (CoCP), which regulates the way that the tram works can be undertaken.

The CoCP sets out standards for our contractor on issues such as controlling noise, vibration and dust. This will ensure that works are undertaken in a responsible and sympathetic manner.

The next stage of works on Lower Road and Fletcher Road is to install the foundations for the underground support structure, so that trams can travel along these roads.

The foundations will be laid by installing 'piles' along the road so that the support structure can then be installed and the tram tracks laid. The 'piles' will be created using the same machinery which was used last summer to carry out test piling in four locations along Lower Road and Fletcher Road.

This work is expected to start on 25th March 2013 and various access and parking restrictions will be needed along Lower Road and Fletcher Road, so that this work can be undertaken.

Further information will be provided about these restrictions in advance of the works.
