NET works update – overnight works on University Boulevard on Saturday 12 July



Various tram works are continuing on University Boulevard (see above photo for progress of tram track laying by the side of University Boulevard) and at the new Queens Road East / University Boulevard junction as part of the expansion of Nottingham's tram network to Beeston and Chilwell.

Lane restrictions in both directions will be in place on University Boulevard on the approach to the Queens Road East junction overnight on Saturday 12 July, from 8pm to 5am the following morning so that works to move traffic over to a new road layout around the T-junction can be carried out safely.

Once this is complete, works to build new pedestrian refuges will take place. Lane restrictions will be in use while this is happening from 9.30am – 3.30pm each day when traffic is lighter, so that the works can be completed safely.

Please be aware that temporary traffic lights will continue to be in use at this T junction during the next stage of the works. Motorists are politely asked to allow extra time when travelling through this area while these works are in progress.

These works will take place between 8am and 6pm Monday – Saturday and will be carried out in accordance with the project's Code of Construction Practice (CoCP).

The tram works on University Boulevard and at the new road junction will be in place until the end of the summer.
