NET works update – Queens Road East Island

As you may be aware, works have been taking place along University Boulevard as part of the expansion of Nottingham's tram network to Beeston and Chilwell.

As part of these works there have been lane restrictions leading to the roundabout at the University Boulevard / Queens Road East junction so that the island can be removed.

From Saturday 16th November the lane restrictions will be removed and a T-junction will be in place with temporary traffic lights.

This will then allow construction works, including piling and track works, to begin across the junction. All the works to build the tram tracks and new road junction are expected to be complete in spring 2014.

These works will be carried out between 8am – 6pm, Monday – Friday and 8am - 1pm on Saturday and will be in accordance with the project's Code of Construction Practice.

Please allow extra time when travelling through this area while these works are in progress.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience these works may cause you, and would like to assure you we will do all that we can to keep disruption to a minimum.
