REPRESENTATION GUIDANCE NOTES

Before making your representations on the proposed Main Modifications to the Aligned Core Strategies (www.broxtowe.gov.uk/corestrategy) we would strongly encourage you to read the following guidance to fully understand the scope of representations which can be made at this stage.

Please note representations can only be made on the matters in the draft Aligned Core Strategy that are subject to proposed Main Modifications, or any associated Sustainability Appraisal matters. It is not considered that any of the proposed modifications give rise to any issues from a Habitats Regulation perspective.

Representations need to fall under two main areas, **legal compliance** or **soundness** (soundness is further broken down into four further areas).

It is anticipated that the majority of representations will relate to the 'soundness' of the Proposed Main Modifications however details on legal compliance matters can be found at:

Soundness

Soundness is explained in [paragraph 182 of the National Planning Policy Framework \(NPPF\)](#). The Inspector has to be satisfied that the plan is positively prepared, justified, effective and consistent with national policy.

- **Positively prepared:** This means that the plan should be prepared based on a strategy which seeks to meet objectively assessed development and infrastructure requirements, including unmet requirements from neighbouring authorities where it is reasonable to do so and consistent with achieving sustainable development.
- **Justified:** The Plan should be the most appropriate strategy when considered against reasonable alternatives, based on proportionate evidence.
- **Effective:** The Plan should be deliverable over its period and based on effective joint working on cross-boundary strategic priorities.
- **Consistent with national policy:** The Plan should enable the delivery of sustainable development in accordance with the policies in the NPPF.

General advice for making representations

- You should try to support your representation, on the modifications, with evidence and it will be helpful if you also say precisely what change you think should be made instead.
- Any comments on the Sustainability Appraisal, Equalities Impact Assessment or Habitat Regulations Assessment relating the main modifications can also be made on the representation form/online form – under the modification number to which the comments relate.
- Where there are groups who share a common view on the proposed modifications and how they would prefer to see the Plan modified, it would be very helpful for that group to send a single representation which represents the view, rather than for a large number of individuals to send in separate representations which repeat the same points. In such cases the group should indicate how many people it is representing and how the representation has been authorised.
- Representations are only valid if your name and address are supplied.
- A form has been produced that will assist people to make representations in the correct manner. Representations can be made through the Borough Council's online consultation system at www.broxtowe.gov.uk/corestrategy. We would strongly encourage the use of the online system.
